## PROJECTS

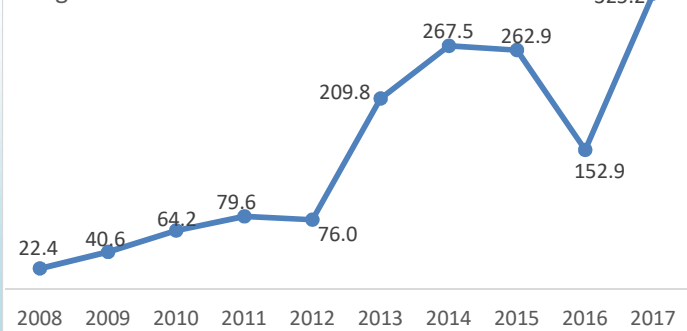
MoSW has implemented 16 Social Security Programmes up to now. In 2017-18, it is implementing 11 Projects, these are;

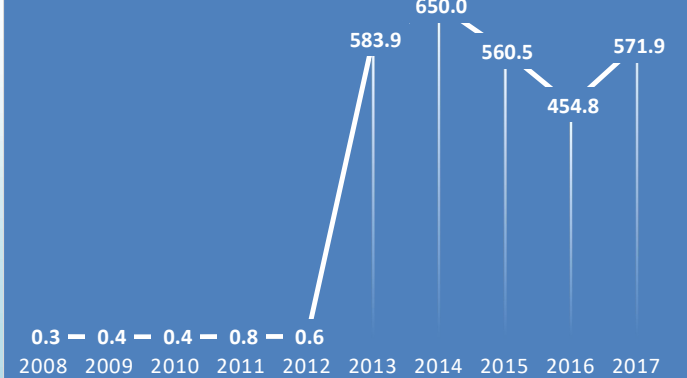
## BUDGET
