All over
Bangladesh

(Except 3 hill districts– Rangamati, Khagrachhari and Bandarban)

Background of the Project

- ▶ Bangladesh is a country where natural calamity occurs frequently;
- ▶ In 1970 a devastating tidal bore and cyclone displaced huge number of people and made millions of them homeless;
- ▶ After the liberation of Bangladesh, the government under the dynamic leadership of the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahamn came forward to rehabilitate the homeless and landless people on khas land.

Background of the Project

- Bangabandhu visited Ramgati Thana of the then Noakhali district on 20th February, 1972 and inaugurated “ Poragacha Cluster Village”.
- He ordered Ministry of land to enhance this programme and to rehabilitate more landless and homeless people.
- Under Adarsha Gram Project-I (July 88 to June 98) a total of 45,647 landless and rootless families were rehabilitated in 1080 AG.

Background of the Project

- ▶ Under Adarsha Gram Project-II (July 98 to December 2008) a total of 25385 landless and rootless families were rehabilitated in 427 AG.
- ▶ Under Guchhogram Project (January 2009 to Sept. 2015) a total of 10703 landless and rootless families were rehabilitated in 254 Guchchhogram funded by JDCF (Japan Debt Cancellation Fund).
- ▶ In continuation of Guchhogram (CVRP) Project, now Ministry of Land is being implementing Guchhogram-2nd Phase (CVRP) Project (October 2015 to June 2020)

Target of the project

- 1.To alleviate the poverty of 50,000 climate victims landless, homeless & addressless families of the rural areas & natural calamities prone areas.
- 2.To establish 2500 Guchchhogram, construct 50,000 dwelling houses & 340 Multipurpose Halls & 150 Ghatla.
3. To ensure safe water & sanitation facilities for all by establishing tube-wells & sanitary latrines and to provide electricity.

Target of the project

4. To provide improved Stove for each family & tree plantation in each Guchchhogram.
5. To provide training on awareness building and skill development to 2 members of each family.
6. To provide credit fund for each rehabilitated family through BRDB.
7. To promote community interaction and raising awareness.

Challenges

- ▶ Not getting enough proposals from many upazils for establishing new Guchhograms;
- ▶ Credit & Training fund is not enough for rehabilitated settlers;
- ▶ Sometimes close monitoring of project activities being hampered in field level for lack of project vehicle.

Learnings

- ▶ Children of rehabilitated 1,12,000 families are going to schools, colleges and many of them doing jobs in different sectors.
- ▶ If the homeless rootless families are given facilities of housing and having job, they can also live with dignity like other people of the society.

Opinions

- ▶ By this project khas (gov. own) land is distributed among the landless rootless families;
- ▶ Landless people become owner of land which help them to built their confidence;
- ▶ Rehabilitated families get the facilities of sanitation, pure drinking water, primary health care, family planning etc;
- ▶ Having credit, training for awareness building and skill development which bring them to the mainstream of the society to alleviate the poverty of county.
