


- Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation (PKSF) was established by the Government of Bangladesh in 1990 Registered under the Companies Act of 1913/1994 with the registrar of Joint Stock Companies.
- Legally, PKSF is a "company not for profit"
- PKSF is as an apex development organization for poverty alleviation through employment creation.

- 2. Dalit (Development of minor group under the LIFT Programme)

# Beggar

- BDT 1,00,000 is used for IGA
- Participants: 1032
- Lifecycle Stages: Old age (60+yrs)
- Thematic Area: Social Allowances
- Success: Most of them are given up begging and self employed
- Learning: Appropriately designed program can enhance their social dignity.
- Recommendation: It can be scaled up nationally.

#### **Dalit**

- Included those who are excluded
- Participants: To improve the lifestyle of the sweepers and cleaners in Biram pur, Dinajpur
- Lifecycle Stages: School Age, Youth and Working Age
- Thematic Area: Human Development
- Success: Developed Self-Confidence
- Learning: Flexibility required to address different needs and priorities
- Recommendation: It could be scaled up in other Dalit groups

#### Education Scholarship to the Children from Disadvantaged Group

- Financial support to safeguard continued study (Spent Tk. Over 20 Crores)
- Participants: 14,550
- Lifecycle Stages: School Age and Youth
- Thematic Area: Human Development
- Success: Students continued their study
- Learning: Careful selection is a key
- Recommendation: It contributes in human development and can expand in disadvantaged areas

## Window of opportunity: 1000 days Health Services

- Health services for the pregnant mother from gestation period to 2 years of a baby (both PNC and ANC) in 1724 unions of 24 districts
- Participants: 64,000 Pregnant mother, 83,000 lactating mother (both ANC and PNC) and 1,27,651 children up to 24 months of age
- Lifecycle Stages: Pregnancy and Early childhood
- Thematic Area: Human Development
- Success: Child and Maternal Mortality reduced
- Learning: Service can be provided at lower cost
- Recommendation: It contributes in human development and can be scaled up nationally.

# Disable Friendly Mobile Training

- Training at the doorsteps
- Participants: 1846 (Farm, off-farm and vocational training)
- Lifecycle Stages: Youth and working age
- Thematic Area: Human Development
- Success: Trained disable persons started both paid and self employment
- Learning: Increase access to TVET
- Recommendation: developed enabling environment for the disable people. They are not disable nether different by able.

# Ujjibito Kishori Club

- Demographic Dividend: Considers the age group11-19 Yrs
- Covers 1727 Unions
- Completed 897 Kishori Club
- Present members: 14,836
- The objective is to mobilise the adolescent girls as a *change maker*
- The activities that include-
  - Education and Training: eg. Improvement of skills and quality.
  - Health and Nutrition: eg. Routine checkup, Nutritional value, and Blood grouping
  - Social Mobilisation: eg. Movement against child marriage and eve-teasing
- Cultural Programs and Sports Functions
- Time period: Nov. 2013- Apr. 2019



# Development of Lifestyle of the Elderly People

- Funding and Community based services for the Elderly
- Participants: 3,00,000 in 234 unions
- Services: Allowances, supportive aids, health and services
- Lifecycle Stages: Old age
- Thematic Area: Social Allowance
- Success: Elderly people can stay their own home and communities.
- Learning: Elderly should be considered in development plan
- Recommendation: There should have elderly centers to exchange their experienced views with younger people

# Special Savings Programms for the Extremely Poor People

- Matching fund for increasing investment capacity
- Participants: 1024 families (Saved nearly 2 crores and PKSF provide 2 crores)
- Lifecycle Stages: Working age and Old age
- Thematic Area: Social Allowance and Livelihood Interventions
- Success: Livelihood capitals particularly physical and financial capacity increased
- Learning: Income increased
- Recommendation: It can be scaled up for those who are destitute but can save
