The NSSS objective of the Ministry is to consolidate social security programmes for all the freedom fighters and their descendants.

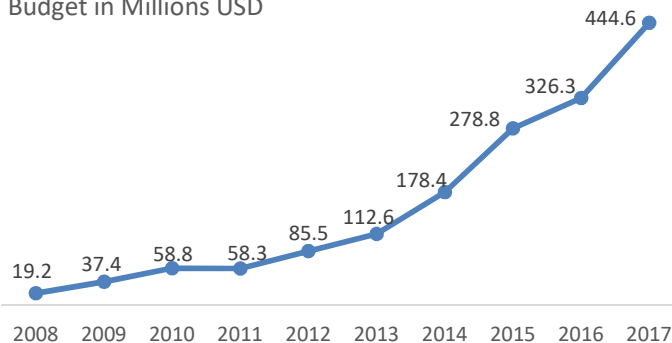
PROJECTS

4. Construction of Residence for Landless and Poor Freedom Fighters

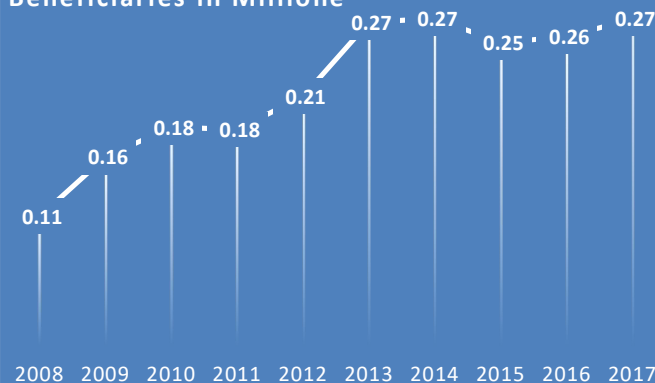
