# Vision and Mission

## **Vision:**

**To see the people healthier, happier and economically productive to make Bangladesh a middle income country by 2021 (Vision 2021)**

## **Mission:**

**To create conditions whereby the people of Bangladesh have the opportunity to reach and maintain the highest attainable level of health**

## Goal

### **Overall Goal:**

**To ensure that all citizens of Bangladesh enjoy health and well-being by expanding access to quality and equitable healthcare in a healthy and safe living environment**

# Safety net program

**Conditional Cash transfer to FP acceptors [LARC and PM]**

**Yearly target around 9.0 lac**

**Yearly budget around 160 crore**

# Rationale of the program

## **FP 2020 global target**

- **Reduce TFR from 2.3 to 2.0**
- **Increase CPR from 62.4% to 75%**
- **Reduce unmet need from 12% to 10%**
- **Reduce discontinuation rate from 30% to 20%**
- **To increase CPR with 20% share of LARC & PM**

# Rationale of the program--

- **Economic development: for every \$1 spent on FP, \$14 saved**
- **Prevent 30% maternal death**
- **Avert 20% newborn deaths**
- **Reduce >66% unintended pregnancy**
- **Reduce unsafe abortion by 40%**

# Contraceptive methods

## **Temporary/short acting method**

- **Oral pill**
- **Condom**
- **Injectable**

## **Long acting method [LARC]**

- **Implant: Single rod-Implanon, effective for 3 years, Double rod-Jadelle, effective for 5 years**
- **IUD [Intra-Uterine Contraceptive Device] effective for 10 years**

# Contraceptive methods--

## **Permanent method [PM]**

- **Bi-Lateral Tubal Ligation [BLTL]**

**Tubectomy for Female**

- **Vasectomy/No-Scalpel Vesectomy [NSV]**

**for male**



# Eligibility criteria for NSV [Male]

- **Should have at least 2 living children with the age of the youngest child at least 1 year**
- **If wife accepted/did tubectomy successfully, no NSV will be allowed**
- **Unmarried, widower, divorced, NSV will not be allowed**
- **The age of wife should be within 49 years**

# Advantage of NSV [male]

- **Permanent**
- **Effective**
- **No side effect**
- **No bleeding**
- **No operation required, no stitching**
- **No pain, takes only 5-9 minutes**
- **No sexual weakness feeling**
- **No worries about pregnancy; full enjoyment during intercourse**

# Dis-advantage of NSV [male]

- **It's a permanent method**
- **Not easy to go back to the previous conditions**
- **Heavy work can not be done for 3-4 days after the NSV has been done; need rest for some time**
- **Water can not be used on the operation area for 1-2 days**
- **Need to use condom for at least 3 months or wife needs to use any method during that time before NSV fully works**

# Eligibility criteria for Tubectomy [female]

- **Should have at least 2 living children with the age of the youngest at least 1 year**
- **Women should have the intention for it**
- **If husband accepted/did NSV successfully, no Tubectomy will be allowed**
- **Unmarried, divorced, Tubectomy will not be allowed**
- **Need to be ensured that client is not pregnant**
- **Client should be both physically and mentally healthy**
- **Husband and wife need to be mutually agreed to accept the method**
- **The age of wife should be within 49 years**

# Advantage of Tubectomy [female]

- **Permanent**
- **Effective**
- **No side effect**
- **No sexual weakness feeling after the method taken**
- **No worries about being pregnant; full enjoyment during intercourse**
- **Easy and safe operation, client can go home within few hours**

# Dis-advantage of Tubectomy [female]

- **It's a permanent method**
- **Not easy to go back to the previous conditions**
- **Though small, it's a operation, and has a little risk**
- **Heavy work can not be done for 3 months after the Tubectomy has been done**
- **Need rest for 7 days**

# Advantage of Implanon [female]

- **Safe, very effective and long lasting**
- **No problems emerge while doing normal work**
- **Effective within 24 hrs of insertion**
- **No sexual weakness feeling after the method taken**
- **No worries about being pregnant; full enjoyment during intercourse**
- **Newly wed couple can also can take this method**

## Dis-advantage of Implanon [female]

- **Need to go to health facility, and needs a small operations for insertion of implanon**
- **Women with hypersensitive to progesterone hormone is not eligible for this method**
- **Sometimes visible from outside**
