








Disability Strikes More with Age, Especially for Women

Intensity of Disabilities by Gender






Huge Inclusivity Gap in Accessing Formal Education

Education of Household Head, SVRS 2023




Gaps in Inclusive Education and Provision




Poverty Hits Hard to Poorest Persons with Disabilities

Wealth Quintile for HHs of Persons with Disabilities, SVRS 2023





Disability Allowance Beneficiary Growth Comparison: FY 2005-06 vs. FY 2024-25




Progression of Monthly Allowances for PwDs: From Initial Phase to Current Fiscal Year under NSSS




